TEMPORARY QUALIFICATION OF RIGHTS IN THE BROKEN WATER SYSTEM

I, Steve Bracks, as Acting Minister administering the *Water Act 1989 (Act)*, make the following Qualification.

Title

1. This Qualification is called the Temporary Qualification of Rights in the Broken Water System July 2007.

Background

2. This Qualification qualifies:
 - rights to water held in accordance with section 8(1) of the Act;
 - the water shares issued in relation to the Broken Water System (**Water System**); and
 - the following bulk entitlements:
 - (a) Bulk Entitlement (Broken System – Goulburn-Murray Water) Conversion Order 2004
 - (b) Bulk Entitlement (Broken System – Goulburn-Murray Water) Conversion Amendment Order 2006
 - (c) Bulk Entitlement (Broken System – Tungamah Domestic and Stock, Urban Supplies - Goulburn-Murray Water) Conversion Order 2004
 - (d) Bulk Entitlement (Broken System – Tungamah Domestic and Stock, Urban Supplies - Goulburn-Murray Water) Conversion Amendment Order 2006
 - (e) Bulk Entitlement (Broken System – Tungamah, Devenish and St James – North East Water) Conversion Order 2004
 - (f) Bulk Entitlement (Broken System – Tungamah, Devenish and St James – North East Water) Conversion Amendment Order 2006.
3. A declaration was made on 20 June 2007 by Alex Marshall, Executive Manager Planning and Environment, Goulburn-Murray Water, as my delegate pursuant to section 33AAA (2) of the Act that a water shortage exists in the Broken Water System (**Water Shortage Declaration**).

Duration

4. This Qualification comes into effect upon notification pursuant to section 33AAC(1) of the Act and remains in force until either:
 - (a) this Qualification or the Water Shortage Declaration is revoked; or
