What are Land and On-Water Management Plans?

These Plans will guide how G-MW and other agencies manage activities, facilities and development on and around water storages. The Plans focus on cultural, recreational, environmental and water quality management issues at water storages but are not designed to make recommendations on storage operations – such as water levels and releases.

Caring for storages this summer

Summer is a busy time of year at dams and lakes around Victoria. You can help protect your water storage and enhance the enjoyment and safety of others by following these simple guidelines:

- Help keep areas around storages clean and protect the environment by taking your rubbish home with you.
- Vehicles and motorbikes may be used on roads open to public vehicles. All vehicles must be registered and drivers licensed. Abide by speed limits.
- A Motor Boat Licence is required when operating a motorised boat in Victorian and NSW waters.
- All plants, animals and historical sites are protected by law and must not be removed or disturbed.

Be safe and take care on our waterways this summer.

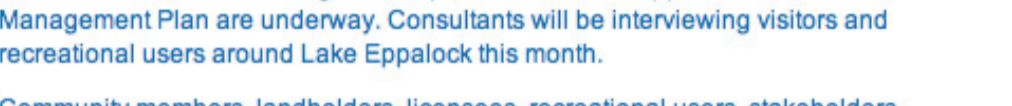

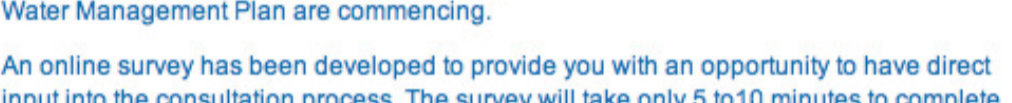
Lake William Hovell
