

This instruction sheet has been prepared to assist with retrieving groundwater information from Visualising Victoria's Groundwater (VVG) website.

Go to www.vvg.org.au and select:

1. VVG Portal

located on the left hand side of the page or alternatively click on the map of Victoria



2. AGREE AND CONTINUE

If you agree with the Terms and Conditions of Use




3. Search

located on the right hand side of the page

4. Address and enter town or road name and Go or


5. Bore ID and enter bore number if known and Go

Hint: State observation bores have the bore number stamped onto them



6. Locate on map

located on left hand side of page and the map will zoom in to the area of interest



7. Click on map in area of interest

Bores within 500 m of the location you clicked will be identified.


Hint: use the zoom function on the left hand side of the page or click and drag to area of interest



8. View details

Select View details of bore of interest from Bore Details list provided.

Hint: select Legend on the left hand side of the page to identify bore type



9. Select tab for information of interest

For example, for groundwater level information select the monitoring tab at the top of the page
