Welcome to the latest edition of e-storage update

This e-storage update is designed to keep you regularly updated on Land and On-Water Management Plans happening at Goulburn-Murray Water storages across northern Victoria.

What are Land and On-Water Management Plans?

These Plans will guide how G-MW and other agencies manage activities, facilities and development on and around water storages. The Plans focus on cultural, recreational, environmental and water quality management issues at water storages but are not designed to make recommendations on storage operations - such as water levels and releases.

Environmental flows to increase water levels below Goulburn Weir River levels downstream of Goulburn Weir are expected to increase this week and throughout November as G-MW releases environmental flows to meet orders placed by the Environmental Water Holders.

River levels may rise as high as 3 metres at the Murchison Gauge which is well below the minor flood level of 9 metres. The average river level for this time of year is around 0.2 metres. Customers and the community can monitor planned releases via daily updates on the G-MW website.

More about your favourite storage

G-MW is currently developing fact sheets and recreational guides for our water storages. These fact sheets will provide information on the history and operation of each storage and will be available from our website and at the storage.

Lake Eildon Commercial houseboat licences

G-MW has been working with existing commercial houseboat operators following the announcement by Minister for Water, Peter Walsh, to boost Lake Eildon with five commercial houseboat licence upgrades.

The initiative will enable existing commercial houseboat operators to upgrade their licences to accommodate larger modern houseboats up to 20 metres long and eight metres wide to be constructed for use on the Lake.

So far the response has been very positive. G-MW expects to issue the new houseboat licences in the coming months.
