What is this application form for?

Use this form to make application for a Licence to Construct or Alter works (bore) for the purpose of groundwater investigation or observation.

This application form incorporates provision for an application for:

- Licence to construct works– new or replacement bore/s (Section 67, Water Act 1989)
- Renewal of a Licence to Construct or Licence to Alter Works (Section 72 Water Act 1989)
- Amendment to a Licence to Construct or Licence to Alter Works(Section 73 Water Act 1989)

What to do:

- Read the accompanying explanatory notes and refer to the current fee schedule (which can be obtained by calling 03 5826 3544 or downloaded from www.g-mwater.com.au) before you fill out the form.
- Complete the form in full ensuring all relevant information is provided.
- Complete the checklist. Incorrect information may result in your application being refused. **We will return Ineligible or incomplete applications.**
- Send the form to Goulburn Murray Water, PO Box 165, TATURA, VIC 3614 and return all relevant information from the checklist below.

General information and explanatory notes (retain for future reference)

What is a bore?

The most common type of bore is a hole which is drilled by a large drilling rig. The definition of a bore also include a sump, well, drag line or any excavation used to intercept, collect and store groundwater for the purpose of taking and using it.

Why do I need a licence to construct a bore?

Under the provisions of the Water Act 1989, any person who constructs, alters or replaces a groundwater bore greater than three metres in depth must obtain a licence to construct works prior to commencing.

What is the difference between an investigation and observation bore?

Investigation bores are constructed for the purpose of investigating the potential to access underground water resources at a specified location. A works licence issued for investigation authorises the drilling of a number of test holes but does not authorise any bores to be retained or constructed after the drilling rig has been removed from the site.

If a works licence is issued for investigation, groundwater may not be taken or used for any purpose.

Observation bores are constructed for the purpose of monitoring groundwater levels at a particular site. Bores may only be constructed to a maximum diameter of 130mm unless specifically approved by G-MW. Water may only be extracted from these bore(s) for the purposes listed below:

- measurement of offsite impacts
- as part of a state or authority measurement network
- observation of environmental issues
- undertaking hydro geological assessments if directed as part of an application for a licence to take and use water

What if I can't get the bore/s drilled or constructed within the 12 month period of the licence?

If the work has not been completed by the expiry date, the licence may be renewed once only. If works have not been carried out within the licence renewal period, an application for a new licence will be required.

Who can drill the bore and when can they start work?

You must engage a licensed driller to drill and construct a new or replacement bore or if you are altering an existing bore. Your nominated driller cannot commence drilling until you have obtained a licence to construct works. The licence conditions must be clearly understood by yourself and your nominated driller before drilling is undertaken.

Do I need to notify G-MW when the bore is completed?

Yes, you should forward the form provided with your licence called the *Notice of Outcome* to G-MW as soon as works are complete. Your licensed driller is responsible for submitting a formal bore completion report to G-MW within 28 days of completion of the works.

What does the application fee cover?

Application fees cover the full cost of undertaking a licence assessment in accordance with G-MW's legal obligations under the *Water Act 1989*.

What happens after I lodge my application?

After you lodge your application G-MW will notify you in writing that it has been received. The timeframe to complete an assessment will vary depending on the nature of your application. When the decision has been made in relation to your application you will be notified in writing of the outcome, either that the application has been approved or refused. Application fees are not refundable if an application is refused.

Question 1 - Application Type

Indicate whether you intend to construct a new bore/s for either investigation or observation. Refer to the notes under general information to determine the correct application type.

Please note the following information if this application is to renew or amend an existing licence.

Renewal of existing Licence to Construct Works - A Licence to Construct Works is valid for 12 months. You may apply to renew a works licence once by lodging an application before the existing licence is due to expire. An existing licence may only be renewed for one further term, if works have not been carried out within the licence renewal period, an application for a new licence will be required.

Amendment to existing Licence to Construct Works - A Licence to Construct Works can be amended providing it has not expired.

You can apply to amend an existing Investigation licence to:

- Change proposed bore site or add additional land/s

You can apply to amend an existing observation licence to:

- Add additional no of bores to be constructed or
- Change proposed bore site or add additional land/s

Question 2 - Applicant/s details

All applicants must complete the application. If any person executes the document on behalf of another person or party, they must provide evidence of their authorisation. This can be in the form of a Power of Attorney or other legal document.

Question 3 - Consultant details

If a consultant will be co-ordinating the works, please provide consultant name and details and they will receive the documentation. If a consultant is making application on behalf of a company, evidence of their authority to make application on behalf of the company must be provided. *Annexure 1 - Proforma for authorisation of agent to sign application form on behalf of applicant* is provided for this purpose.

Question 4 - Description of land on which the bore/s will be constructed

Applicants must provide details of the land/s where the bore/s are to be constructed. The current ownership of this land must also be verified. To ensure this information is accurate G-MW requires a current copy of the title/s for all land. If the bore/s are located on land that is not in the applicant's ownership, written consent from the landowner also is required. Please complete *Annexure 2 - Consent of Landowner* for this purpose.

A Registered Title Search Statement for each separate title must be provided. Rates notices cannot be accepted. An example of an acceptable Registered Search Statement is attached.

If the bore is to be constructed on crown land, consent and/or permits issued by the relevant authorities (eg. Vic Roads, DSE, Shire etc) must accompany the application. If you need to obtain copies of these documents please contact the local office of the Department of Sustainability and Environment or the Shire administering the permits for this crown land.

How can I get a copy of my titles?

You can obtain a registered search statement for land titles by:

- Requesting that G-MW complete the searches on your behalf.
- Contacting your solicitor or legal advisor to conduct the search on your behalf (fees may apply)

Question 5 - Number and details of new bore/s to be constructed

Please provide details about the proposed bore/s. Ensure you include the number of bore/s being constructed and the maximum proposed depth of the bore/s.

Question 6 - Licensed driller to undertake construction

You must engage a licensed driller to drill and construct the bore. Your nominated driller can not commence drilling until you have obtained a Licence to Construct Works. The licence conditions must be clearly understood by yourself and your nominated driller before the works commence.

Upon completion of the bore, the driller must lodge a Bore Completion Report with G-MW within 28 days.

Question 7 - Declaration of applicant/s

All applicants must sign the application. If any person executes the document on behalf of another person or party, they must provide evidence of their authorisation. This can be in the form of a Power of Attorney or other legal document.

If the applicant is a company, evidence must be provided that the person/s signing the application has authority to sign on behalf of the Company. This must be in the form of a current copy of an ASIC Company Search listing all directors and/or office bearers which is not more than three months old.
