WATER SHARE OWNER IDENTITY CHECK FORM INSTRUCTIONS

The form must be lodged along with the application to transfer a water share with the water corporation. A separate ID check form must be completed by each water share owner.

Who must complete the ID check

- A separate identity check form must be completed for each owner of the water share.
- If a water share owner is a company, signatories for the company must complete an identity check in accordance with an Australian Securities and Investment Commission (ASIC) company extract that is **less han 12 months old**.
- If a water share owner is a legal entity other than a registered company (such as an incorporated association or government body etc), signatories for the legal entity must complete the identity check. Evidence of the authorised signatories must also be provided. This can be in the form of the minutes of a meeting, or another document indicating the signatories are authorised to sign on behalf of the organisation. The document provided must be less than 12 months old and must list the current legal name of the organisation.

Who can verify the identity check

- An Australian legal practitioner is generally a lawyer, solicitor, or barrister that holds a current practicing certificate. Australian legal practitioners does not include Justice of the Peace.
- Qualified Accountant as defined under the Corporations Act 2001 Section 88B

Requirements for ID documents that you may use

- You may use an expired passport if it had only expired within the last two years. However, the passport must not have been cancelled.
- Utility account statements must be less than 12 months old.
- All other identification must be current.
- If you do not have a: passport; drivers licence; or a firearm licence you may provide a statutory declaration witnessed by someone who has known you for at least two years.
 - The Statutory Declaration **must** clearly state the following:
 - Name, Address, Occupation & Date of Birth (of the person being identified)
 - The length of time the person being identified and the Authorised Witness have known each other (must be more than 2 years)
 - The nature of the relationship between the person being identified and the Authorised Witness
 - The Authorised Witness is not a party to the water share being transferred.
 - An **Authorised Witness** who may sign a Statutory Declaration must be either a:
 - a bank manager
 - a court officer
 - a local government office holder
 - a senior officer of a council
 - a doctor or nurse
 - a public servant
 - a police officer

If your name has changed

If the name on your water share is different to your identity documents, you must provide change of name documentation or a marriage certificate

Re-using the Identity check

The water corporation, at their discretion, may agree to re-use this identity check for up to 3 months after submission to them.

Privacy statement

The Department of Energy, Environment & Climate Action (DEECA), Goulburn-Murray Water, Lower Murray Water and Southern Rural Water (the water corporations) are committed to protecting personal information provided by you in accordance with the principles of the Victorian privacy laws. The information you provide will be made available to water corporation staff, agents and contractors to the extent necessary to process this application and to provide services to you or the water corporation itself. Information on water entitlements are publicly available via the Victorian Water Register. The information you provide will be also used for de-identified statistical water information. Refer to the water corporations' website for more information on their privacy policies.

Access to information about you

You have the right to access and correct information about you that is held by the water corporations and DELWP. In most cases requests for access will be administered through the Freedom of Information Act 1982, particularly requests that in affect the privacy of another individual or relate to a commercial activity.
