West Goulburn Groundwater Management Area

The West Goulburn Groundwater Management Area (GMA) extends from Wandong-Heathcote Junction, north to the River Murray incorporating the towns of Kilmore, Broadford, Rushworth, Kyabram and Barmah (shown on map overleaf).

The 2017/18 season marks the first year of implementation of the West Goulburn GMA Local Management Plan.

Groundwater resources

Rainfall recorded in the West Goulburn GMA in 2017/18 was below average however groundwater levels remained relatively stable. Groundwater level and rainfall charts are provided overleaf.

Groundwater licensed volume and use

The licensed volume in the West Goulburn GMA is 2,814.4 megalitres per year (ML/yr) (Table 1). There is no permissible consumptive volume (PCV) limiting licensed volume in the West Goulburn GMA, however there are individual zone caps set.

Recorded use in the West Goulburn GMA in 2017/18 was 1,205.1 ML, 43% of total licensed volume (Table 1).




Figure 1 Annual recorded use as a proportion of licensed volume in the West Goulburn GMA

Groundwater use in 2017/18 is 15% more than the volume used in 2016/17 (Figure 1). This is consistent with 2017/18 being much drier than 2016/17.

Groundwater trading

Licence holders may transfer licensed volume on a temporary or permanent basis, within or between management zones, provided zone limits documented in the Local Management Plan are not exceeded.

No trades were undertaken in 2017/18.

Licence holders with metered bores may carryover unused entitlement up to a maximum of 10% of their licensed volume in the West Goulburn GMA customers in 2018/19.
