

Broken Groundwater Management Area

The Broken Groundwater Management Area (GMA) extends from the upper catchment near Mansfield, north to Tungamah and incorporates the towns of Benalla, Glenrowan and Dookie (shown on map overleaf).

Groundwater resources

Groundwater resources within the GMA occur in either fractured bedrock aquifers, shallow shoestring sands of the Shepparton Formation, or deep gravel and sands of the Deep Lead. Charts showing groundwater levels and rainfall are provided overleaf.

In 2019/20 groundwater levels in the Shepparton Formation aquifer continued to fluctuate in response to climatic conditions.

The Deep Lead and bedrock aquifers continue to follow a steadily rising trend.

Groundwater licensed volume and use

There is currently 2,993.0 megalitres per year (ML/yr) of groundwater licensed entitlement volume (licensed volume) in the GMA (Table 1). Licensed volume in the GMA is limited by a permissible consumptive volume (PCV) of 3,732.0 ML/yr.

Table 1 Licensed volume and recorded use in the Broken GMA

Recorded use in the GMA in 2019/20 was 508.8 ML, which is 17 per cent of total licensed volume (Table 1).




Figure 1. Annual recorded use as a proportion of licensed volume in the Broken GMA

Groundwater use decreased by five per cent in the GMA compared to 2018/19 (Figure 1), likely attributed to an increase in rainfall.

Groundwater trading

Licence holders may transfer licensed volume on a temporary or permanent basis within or between management zones in the Broken GMA and other Groundwater Management Units, provided that it accords with rules outlined in the Local Management Plan.

One permanent trade of 95 ML/yr occurred in 2019/20, into the Broken Sedimentary Plains Zone from the Mid Goulburn GMA.

Transferring licensed volume can provide an opportunity to generate income from unused entitlement for sellers, or increase production for buyers.







