## Main Topics Discussed

<b>Water Resource Seasonal Outlook –</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The members were provided with the current storage levels and the possible water availability for 2017/18.</li><li>• Discussion around climate models which are driving dryer conditions as there is a belt of high pressure in southern hemisphere pushing cold fronts and moisture southward.</li><li>• The current risk of spill was discussed together with the trade opportunities.</li></ul>
<b>Web Security Update – AI</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provided the committee with the current security systems in place and queried whether the committee felt they were adequate. He provided industry examples of the various types of security applications that are available.</li><li>• The members suggested that the security could possibly be increased but on an individual's option basis.</li></ul>
<b>Winter Works Update –</b>
