## Main Topics Discussed

### Tariff Strategy Working Groups

- WSC members who attended the Tariff Strategy Working Group Induction Day provided an overview of the session and gave insight into the issues raised by the various customer categories.
- Members highlighted their concerns of the operational costs associated with managing access of landowners who are not existing GMW customers and access water under Section 8 of the Water Act 1989 rights. Representatives on the Tariff Strategy Working Group would flag these costs as part of future discussions and would look for opportunities to recover associated costs as part of the tariff review.

## WSC Structure

- The committee discussed the future structure of Water Service Committees and agreed that the current approach of assessing the need to hold a meeting should continue.
- Members agreed that the frequency of meetings should be flexible and in consideration of the issues at hand.
