Main Topics Discussed

Transformation Project Channel by Channel - John Weber, Jeremey Nolan, Fiona Archer

- Presented an update on the Channel by Channel Review.
- It was explained that the channel by channel information can be used as an assessment tool to make future strategic decisions as well as maintenance decision of structures.
- All member agreed in principal that it would be a useful tool for the better management of assets for area managers.

Cockatoo Lagoon/Thompson Weir, Living Murray, Gunbower Project update - Greg Watkins, Chris Kelly

- An update was provided to the committee regarding Gunbower Project, including Cockatoo Lagoon.
- The committee was advised that recent analysis of soil within Cockatoo Lagoon has identified ASS Soils (Sulphate soil), which will now have significant impact on any future decisions, a risk assessment is now required, if soils are exposed to sunlight/disturbed could have significant impact on flora and fauna.
- Ongoing liaison with customers continues regarding pre-emptive rights and with the Cockatoo Working Group.

WSC Operating Rules Review – Greg Shannon

- Operating rules were briefly discussed.
- Committee considered the currently voting process being based on delivery shares should remain the same and should not change.
- Chair and Deputy Chair tenure committee agreed 1 year should remain the same.
- Committee discussed concern over the item 5.7.4, which is regarding media and political interaction: the
 committee members believe currently this restricts them as identifying themselves as a WSC member for
