## Main Topics Discussed

<b>Pricing Submission – Ann Telford, Daniel Irwin, Greg Shannon</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provided an overview of the engagement process and what GMW has heard from customers and stakeholders.</li><li>• A key result from this work has indicated a significant reduction in revenue requirement is needed for Water Plan 5 (WP5).</li><li>• Entitlement Storage Fees; the Committee was pleased to see the proposed removal of the price difference between water users and non-water users.</li><li>• The Committee agreed in principle to uniform pricing and saw the need for the same service standards across the GMID.</li></ul>
<b>Inter Valley Trade – Ann Telford</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provided an update and explanation on the recent announcement made by the Water Minister regarding the changes to the IVT rules.</li><li>• These rules are to help protect the Goulburn River and that previous prolonged high volumes of delivery were causing environmental impacts</li><li>• The committee was concerned how the rules were implemented and the short timeframe around the decision.</li><li>• The committee discussed concerns about the impact on customers connected to Macorna main from Pyramid district as part of the Connection program.</li></ul>
