Main Topics Discussed

Greater Water Market Transparency – Mark Mitchell (DELWP)

- Provided an informative presentation covering items regarding trade of both Water Shares and Allocation.
- Discussion on the effects the new Inter Valley Trade (IVT) rules for tagged water effective 1st
 December 2019 are going to have on customers, particularly with some customers having been
 moved from channel irrigation to river diversion as part of the Connections Program.
- Gave an overview of historical trade patterns and market prices of both Water Shares and Allocation across Northern Victoria.
- The Water Market Transparency Options Paper is open for consultation until 08 November 2019.

GMW Customer Complaint and Dispute Management - Fabian McCloy & Lou Kerrins

- Presented GMW's Complaint Management and Dispute policy.
- Explained the definition of a complaint and GMW's responsibilities for logging and keeping records of complaints to the committee.

Connection Project - Peter Egglestone & Natalie Sharp
