## Main Topics Discussed

<b>Update on Water Trade Trends – Mark Mitchell</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provided the committee with information on the current water trade trends and advised that the initial report completed back in 2014/15 had now been updated.</li><li>• Members were updated on a new “notification” app that will be available in May and how live information on trade limits can be sourced from DELWP’s newly constructed schematic</li><li>• The committee had an opportunity to inform DELWP of their concerns regarding water security, Carryover and water not being linked to land – that speculators have.</li></ul>
<b>Pricing Update – Greg Shannon</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Presented GMW’s annual price review and provided timelines on the approved prices that will be applied on July 1 2019.</li><li>• WSC asked questions on how the service point fees are calculated.</li></ul>
<b>Peter Egglestone – Engineering, Interface Manager Connections</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Advised Connections are planning a busy 2019 winter program, consisting of pipelines and channel rationalisations on spur channels.</li><li>• No plastic lined channels in scope.</li><li>• A number of new meters are still being installed and meters rationalised where possible.</li><li>• West Loddon supply (to customers) was raised as a project that Connections could investigate.</li></ul>
