Main Topics Discussed

Water Market Trends Report - DELWP

- The presentation summarised the Water market trends report and fact sheets provided to WSC and made available on the Victorian Water register site.
- This generated plenty of debate and questions.
- WSC raised concerns about the significant river losses in delivering environmental water below the Barmah choke and through to South Australia.
- A demonstration of a new application which will be available for all customers to view allocation trading limits and opportunities was provided.

Engineering, Interface Manager Connections - Peter Egglestone

- Advised Connections are planning a busy 2019 winter program.
- More pipelines and channel rationalisations on spur channels.
- No plastic lined channels in scope.
- New meters are still being installed and meters rationalised where possible.

Annual Price Review - Brendan Brooks & Peter Clydesdale

- A presentation was provided on the annual price review.
- WSC feel storage fees should be the same for water user and Non Water User.
- WSC would like a greater understanding of the environmental levy expense.
- WSC felt the Shepparton Infrastructure Access Fee would transition through Pricing Submission5 to a more comparative price with the other five districts. Potentially assisting with transition to a single GMID price in Pricing Submission 5.
