<b>Torrumbarry Land on Water Management Plan (LWMP) – Mandy Coulson (NCCMA)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provided a presentation to the committee regarding LWMP project which provided an outline of the scope and guidelines for the project including timeframes and focus group data collected to date.</li><li>• The committee-discussed data collected so far which identifies positive changes to farming practices due to less rain and increasing cost of water for irrigation. These include a noted increase in piggery, investment in goats, and changes to farming practices for dairies, including free stall, and barn dairies.</li></ul>
