# Main Topics Discussed

## Northern Victoria Water Resource Plan – Sabrina Tederowski

- Presented on Victoria's North and Murray Water Resource Plan (WRP).
- Presentation covered an overview of the WRP, what it does and does not do, and what needs to be looked at in the WRP.
- Good discussions were held around such things as where irrigator rights fit into the WRP, priorities around human consumption v environmental needs, and potential adverse outcomes from environmental watering.
- Looked at the next stages in development/approvals of the WRP.

# Transformation / Customer Charter Update – Stephen Gemmill

- Provided the Committee with a Transformation update.
- Looked at the Transformation timelines, Critical Decisions, the Conditions of Satisfaction and Identified Operational savings.
- Presentation also covered System & Process improvements.
- Also provided the Committee with a brief overview of the changes made to the Customer Charter in response to Recommendation 21 in the SAP Review of GMW.

#### North East Land and Water Management Plan (NELWMP) Renewal – Brooke Hermans

- Provided an update on the NELWMP Renewal.
- Session gave an overview and explained the purpose of the Land and Water Management Plan.
- Presentation covered the five main program areas and provided clarity around each of the activities associated with them.
- Committee were advised of the consultation process on the draft Plan, the questions for feedback, and how to have their say.
- Committee didn't identify gaps in the proposed programs and activities.

# Water Resources Update / Seasonal Outlook - Bob Knowles

- Provided a Water Resource update.
- Looked at current availability, recent conditions, seasonal & system outlooks, and key messages for this season and next.
- Also looked at Ovens and King Restriction curves and the Murray shortfall risk.

#### Groundwater & Streams Update – Andrew Harbour / Suzanne Hayes

- Outlined what has been happening in the unregulated & groundwater space in the East.
- Looked at stream flows and the current level of restrictions in the Ovens and King catchments.
- Provided a thorough overview of groundwater levels, usage, trades etc in the Katunga and Upper Ovens WSPA's, and the Lower Ovens GMA.
- Andrew advised the Committee where things are up to in relation to the Lower Ovens GMA LMP review, including proposed amendments and the next steps.

## Customer Engagement – Ann Telford

- Provided background to the review of the WSC's, needing to consider how they might look into the future and the role they might play.
- The Committee were asked a series of questions in this space and provided feedback accordingly.
