Main Topics Discussed

Channel x Channel Principles - Daniel Irwin, Jeremy Nolan & John Weber

- GMW asked the WSC to look at a Pod of channels within the Central Goulburn Irrigation district and analyse the available data to provide recommendation on the asset maintenance criticality and type of appropriate maintenance options.
- Long, Medium & short term treatment options on bridges, culverts, channels, pipelines, regulators & meters were considered.
- The mini workshop was a positive exercise with good engagement from the committee.
- The ChannelxChannel Principles team will take away the feedback from the committee and will next meeting present the populated matrix based on this information.

Service Plan Update - Matthew O'Farrell

- Advised on the service plans strategy / engagement with key stakeholders aims for WP6/7
- It includes understanding current state, Work packages, Finalisation and financial modelling.
- Displayed a list of items that may be included in work packages for irrigation and drainage.
- It was discussed that a review into the impact of termination of delivery shares from water to irrigators should be included on the service plan.

Water Efficiency Project (WEP) - Peter Egglestone

- Provided an update on the WEP program by giving an overview of the project scope

Public Pump Rationalisation - Rachel Bradshaw
