Main Topics Discussed

GMW Integrated Enhance Debt Recovery Program and Gravity Financial Results – Michael Gomez

- Provided the committee a presentation which outlined the current sustained long term debt against customers' accounts which is approximately 11 million
- The committee was advised that focus on debt recovery program aims to stabilise and reduce customer debt while also aligning with hardship process for those customers in financial difficulty
- The Irrigators Share Distribution (ISD) project offers an opportunity to implement debt recovery program with the objective to reduce debt.
- Final step GMW debt recovery process will be applied, which will be warrant or sale of assets and or property
- The committee was also briefed on the gravity financial results which at this time are on track

Goulburn to Murray Trade Rule changes - Alex Murray - DELWP

- Updated WSC on the 21/22 interim rules, advised regarding flexibility in trade rule, testing monitoring program along with liaison with stakeholder
- Operating plan and trade rules were explained with the cap of 190GL
- A three year monitoring program will be undertaken with traditional owners, NCCMA & scientists to assess impact on Aboriginal cultural values, riverbank vegetation, native fish species and habitats
- Operating plan to be publically released in September 2021
- WSC will kept updated and their feedback will be sought

Update on Allocations, Reserve Policy - Mark Bailey

- A briefing was provided outlining current allocations and storage inflows are all good
- Reserve allocation will be reviewed by DELWP once ISD is complete, it is likely reserves will be reduced as part of the review
